NURS 1132 Pre-Nursing Preparation

The Pre-Nursing Preparation course has been designed to promote success in the nursing program. Students will be assisted in evaluating their own learning styles and discovering their most effective study methods. An explanation of cognitive levels of test questions is included, with emphasis on application-style questions found in nursing course exams, as well as in the national licensure exam. Exercises in critical thinking will be integrated throughout the course. Exposure to the use of nursing informatics and time management skills will further enhance the student's probability of success in the nursing program.

REQUIRED TEXT, REFERENCES, AND MATERIALS

Bi-weekly quizzes are graded immediately upon completion and are reviewable once submitted. There is a time limit for each quiz. Each quiz allows you only 1 attempt. Please read the assignments and review the study guide prior to attempting the quiz. Discussion questions will be evaluated no later than one (1) week after assigned due date for the response.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

For the assignments specified, the student will complete the assignments as directed below in an ONLINE format. No hard-copies will be accepted.

Discussion Questions:

- 1) There will be seven modules each with separate discussion questions posted to the online classroom (Brightspace) under the discussion forum. The student is required to post a ***substantial answer*** to each question. The answer should be ***complete and reflective***. The initial post is due 3 days prior to the response due date.
- 2) Also, the student will be responsible to give a response/comment about another student's answer/comment regarding the same question. For each question, both the student's answer and comment should be included in the same post/Brightspace for tracking and grading purposes. All answers need to be presented in sentence format for this assignment. The assignment will be submitted ONLINE to Brightspace as directed by instructor.

A total of 8 points per question is possible and distributed according to the following criteria:

3 points: Appropriately answered the question(s) as assigned.

3 points: Responded to one of the questions posed by peers.

2 points: Met the expectations by answering and/or responding to two or more questions/peers comments.

NOTE: Comments such as "I agree" or "I don't agree" without substantial rationale as to WHY you agree or disagree will not be considered as a graded response to a peer's comments.

AUTHORIZED TOOLS

LATE WORK

All assignments are due by 11:59pm on the date provided. **Late work is not accepted and will be counted as a zero.** All assignments and quizzes are scheduled in the course syllabus. It is not reasonable to expect that quizzes/discussion posts will be rescheduled except in the case of an **EMERGENCY**, e.g. death in the immediate family or significant illness of the student. In case of an **EMERGENCY**, the student must notify the instructor prior to the time quiz or post is due. Failure to make arrangements (within 24 hours) to complete the assignment will result in a grade of “zero” recorded. Appropriate documentation (e.g., doctor’s statement, obituary) must be provided.
