## **COURSE MODULES**

This course is organized into 12 modules, each covering one chapter of the required textbook. Modules can be accessed in the “content” area in online classroom course. Each module follows a similar format including chapter objectives, readings, PowerPoint presentations, activities and/or discussion questions, assignments and each ends with a chapter quiz.

## **COURSE ACTIVITIES**

Assignment schedule, details and due dates will be posted in the “content” tab of the online classroom and located in the course schedule. It is the responsibility of the student to make sure that all assignments are submitted correctly and on time, according to the assignment instructions. Any assignments not submitted correctly or on time will be considered late.

### 1. Course Discussion

- a) **Assigned Discussion:** There are 11 discussion forums for this course: one per module (except module 12). For each of these assignments you will be asked to respond to a question posted by the instructor. You will provide an original post answering the question and will also be asked to respond to/comment on the postings of at least 2 other students. A grading rubric is listed below. There is also a discussion forum for introductions. Your introduction post is worth 10% of the grade.
- b) **Additional Discussion:** You will also find discussion forums in which you can post general questions, comments, etc. This forum is viewed by the course instructor and visible to all students, but is not graded.
- c) **Instructor Role:** Instructor will review discussion posts and comment as necessary and appropriate to facilitate discussion, answer questions and correlate discussion to course objectives. Do not expect an instructor comment for every student post.

### 2. Quizzes:

Quizzes should be completed in order and within the week they are assigned. If for some reason you are unable to complete a quiz by the posted due date, please communicate with the instructor as soon as possible. While quizzes have set end dates, they are all open from the first day of class—feel free to work ahead if you are able.

### 3. Assignments:

There are two assignments in this course in module 6 and 12. Please see instructions in the content tab of online classroom.

### 4. Additional Material:

Any other resources provided by textbook company, whether online or in the textbook, are optional learning opportunities meant for the student’s own edification.

## **RUBRIC FOR WEEKLY DISCUSSION FORUMS**

Weekly instructions can be found under the "Discussion" tab on the tool bar at the top of your screen in online classroom.

**Weekly Discussion Participation:** Your web discussion postings will be examined for scholarly contributions weekly.

A total of 10 points per discussion assignment is possible and distributed according to the following criteria: **Late submissions will not be accepted**

6 points: Appropriately answered the question(s) as assigned **by the due date**.

4 points: Read other students post and responded to at least 2 other students **by the due date**.

**NOTE: Comments such as "I agree" or "I don't agree" without substantial rationale as to WHY you agree or disagree will not be considered as a graded response to a peer's comments.**
