Executive Summary

The Alumni Survey is a tool used to check-in on graduates approximately one year after graduation to determine the positive placement rate and "success" of these graduates by program. This survey also provides an opportunity to update contact information and helps maintain the lines of communication between Oklahoma State University Institute of Technology and those who can support the institution in a number of ways. This 2018 alumni cohort consists of students who graduated during the 2016-2017 academic year (summer 2016 through spring 2017) resulting in a range of respondents who are anywhere from eight to 16 months post-graduation. The OSUIT Office of Institutional Research administered the Alumni Survey entirely online.

Of the 672 alumni who graduated during the 2016-2017 academic year, 663 had viable email addresses and were invited to participate in this survey; 103 responded to the survey for a response rate of 15.5 percent. Fifty-eight percent of respondents were male, 75 percent of those reporting addresses live in Oklahoma, and the largest number of respondents (17) graduated from the School of Engineering Technologies (A.A.S. and B.T.) programs followed closely by the School of Information Technologies (16) and Nursing and Health Sciences (16). Seventy-one percent (73/103) reported employment; 18 percent reported continuing their education; four percent reported seeking employment, while the remaining six percent reported *not* seeking employment.

Among employed alumni, 81 percent (59/73) reported full-time employment; one of these reported military service as employment. Sixty-six percent of employed alumni reported employment prior to graduation, while 84 percent reported employment within 6 months of graduation. Of the 62 respondents reporting salary data, ten reported earnings in excess of \$70,000 per year. Alumni reported salary data with a median pay range of \$45,000 to \$49,999.

Alumni expressed the highest levels of satisfaction (either 4= Satisfied or 5= Very Satisfied) with "Instructors' willingness to help me meet my educational goals" (76%) and in the following *skills* areas:

- Technical skills (74.8%)
- Analytical skills (74.8%)
- Time management skills (74.8%)
- Professional/ethical behavior (74.8%)
- Taking direction from supervisor (74.8%)
- Independent decision-making (73.8%)

Alumni expressed lowest satisfaction (same scale as above, either 4= Satisfied or 5= Very Satisfied) in the following areas:

- Student club or organization associated with my program (48.5%)
- Opportunities for off-campus practical experience in my chosen career field (56.3%)
- OSUIT helped me prepare to interact with people from diverse backgrounds (59.2%)
- Quality of on-campus applied learning and practical experiences (60.2%)

Following is a five-year summary of the rates of positive responses (ratings of 4 or 5-- satisfied or very satisfied-- on a five-point scale) for each scale item as listed in the alumni survey with a line graph showing differences across the five-year span.

Note: When interpreting these results, remember that some areas of focus are less important or may not apply to alumni from non-technical programs or without internship experiences. In such cases, these may result in fewer responses or lower percentages of positive scores (ex., off-campus field experience or taking direction from a supervisor), particularly if the alumni continued their education and had not yet entered the workforce. In addition, graphs showing a changes from year to year do not imply statistical significance; they are merely visual cues indicating change.
