

# **Transfer-out Report**

June 2019

### Introduction

The Transfer-out Feedback Form is a self-report instrument that addresses the needs and expectations of respondents upon first arrival at OSUIT and perceptions of the transfer process from OSUIT to their subsequent transfer institution. Satisfaction scales were included in this survey that align with student satisfaction scales used in other surveys on the OSUIT campus. The transferred students were also asked to provide their current grade-point average at their transfer institution in an attempt to identify some aspect of academic achievement after leaving OSUIT.

### Method

The sample for this fourth annual administration of the Transfer-out Feedback Form consisted of students (including graduates) from academic year 2017-2018 who transferred to another institution by the start of the spring 2019 semester; these students were identified using data from the National Student Clearinghouse. Because the survey was administered online, students must also have a valid email address on file. In total, 270 previously enrolled students were invited to participate. An invitation email was sent on 03/01/2019 with seven follow-up reminders, each including the link to the survey. The survey closed on 04/30/2019 with 31 viable responses for an 11.5 percent response rate.

### Results

In this 2019 group (again, academic year 2017-2018 transfer-outs):

- Gender skewed much more *female* (71%) in 2019 than in previous years.
- 35.5% were in Arts & Sciences (declared majors only).
- 80.7% found OSUIT to be as expected upon arrival on campus.
- 87.1% had everything they needed upon arrival at OSUIT.
- 29.0% found that, over time, their expectations of OSUIT changed.
- OSUIT fell short for 25.8%, exceeded expectations for 32.26% in 2019; both are higher rates than previous years.
- 67.7% report GPA at the transfer institution as 3.0 or above.
- 25.8% reported earning an associate degree while at OSUIT.
- 19.4% reported transferring general education courses as difficult/somewhat difficult.
- 22.6% repeated gen-ed courses taken at OSUIT for transfer to current institution.
- 38.7% needed to add gen-ed courses not taken at OSUIT for transfer to current institution.
- 16.1% took more gen-ed courses than needed before transfer to current institution.

### **Observations**

Student comments varied greatly with both positive and negative remarks, matter-of-fact criticisms, and a number of items to address. Several students reportedly left to pursue different majors or bachelor degrees. While many (74.2%) reported the process with transferring credits to another institution as easy/somewhat easy, not all transfers played out seamlessly.

Satisfaction with OSUIT was measured using scales commonly applied to other surveys on campus with a focus on 1) academic programs, 2) student services, 3) gains acquired through OSUIT to show preparedness, and 4) summary items that reflect general satisfaction with OSUIT that the student intends to share with others. As with all the results included in this report, low participation over the

past four years makes generalizability of the findings relatively weak. In addition, the ratio of female-to-male respondents was uncharacteristic; it does not reflect the composition of the campus population. Take caution with the interpretation of the findings, to follow, on the student satisfaction scales:

- Academic Services: Over the past four years, satisfaction with instructors has generally improved, particularly with regard to communication with student, quality of instructors in both gen-ed and technical majors, and instructor professionalism. Satisfaction with degree advisement fell this year. Satisfaction for the student organizations associated with majors/programs, though low, showed improvement this year.
- Student Services: A small decline was noted for satisfaction in Admissions/Recruitment and the
  Assessment Center; more substantial declines were reported in the areas of Counseling, Lasso
  Center, Registrar's Office/Enrollment, and Student Financial Services; satisfaction with the
  Bursar's Office and the Library remained unchanged from the previous year.
- Gains acquired at OSUIT: Agreement increased over the past year for statements such as "OSUIT helped me gain the proper skills needed for my chosen career", "OSUIT helped prepare me to interact with people from diverse backgrounds", and OSUIT helped me achieve my educational goals." To a lesser extent, agreement increased for the statements "OSUIT provided opportunities for hands-on experience..." and "OSUIT helped me build contacts with professionals..." in their chosen career fields.
- Summary Items: Over the past four years, satisfaction on the summary items was highest in 2019. Results show that 64.5 percent of students transferring to other schools would recommend OSUIT to family and friends; 71.0 percent would choose to attend OSUIT again; and 77.4% were satisfied with their college experience at OSUIT overall.

Satisfaction percentages noted above were drawn from the sum of percentages for the two highest positive responses in a scale, such as *Satisfied/Very Satisfied*. The following tables summarize the responses by transfer students for the past four years beginning with *Demographics*, followed by *Needs and Expectations*, *Satisfaction with Academic Programs*, *Satisfaction with Student Services*, *Gains Acquired at OSUIT*, and the *Summary Items*.
