

WITHDRAWING STUDENTS

Summary

Student retention continues to be a focal point for Oklahoma State University Institute of Technology (OSUIT). The OSUIT Retention Task Force promotes efforts to determine why students leave the university without completing their programs of study; as we identify actionable reasons for these withdrawals, we focus resources on correcting conditions that lead to these withdrawals. By minimizing deterrents, retention of our student population should improve. The first step remains—to determine what forces influence students leading them to decide to withdraw from school. The *Withdrawal Survey* continues to play a part in these efforts.

The Institutional Research Office received 246 completed *Student Withdrawal Request Forms* that included *Withdrawal Survey* data for academic year 2017-2018. Please note that the *Student Withdrawal Request Form* has two parts: The front page, the *Student Withdrawal Request Form*, provides the Registrar's Office essential contact information, an explanation of reasons for withdrawal, and signatures of required contacts prior to withdrawal. On the back of the form is the *Withdrawal Survey*, used by the Office of Institutional Research, to collect additional information such as intent to return, use of particular services, and opportunities to provide feedback on services and other ways to help students stay in school. Although some of the information from the *Student Withdrawal Request Form* (front page) is useful for institutional research purposes, most of the information reported herein is based on responses to the *Withdrawal Survey* on the back of the form (see Appendix D for a copy of the *Student Withdrawal Request Form* which includes the *Withdrawal Survey*).

Student Withdrawal Request Form

Fourteen respondents (5.7%) noted receiving veteran/military education benefits. Understandably, most withdrawals occurred during the fall 2017 semester (54.5%). While 48.4 percent (down from 62.8 percent from the previous year) planned to return to OSUIT (*Student Withdrawal Request Form*), two-thirds of these suggested a time. More canceled *before* census (58.5%) than withdrew *after* census (37.0%). Reasons for withdrawal, as reported on the *Student Withdrawal Request Form*, varied greatly. The reasons listed on the *Student Withdrawal Request Form* were in the form of brief narratives provided by the withdrawing students (Appendix B).

Withdrawal Survey

While withdrawing students come to OSUIT from widely varied academic histories, the highest percentage of withdrawals (49.2%) attended high school prior to coming to OSUIT. Although 62.8 percent of withdrawing students said they planned to return to OSUIT on the *Student Withdrawal Request Form*, only 39.8 percent stated they would re-enroll at OSUIT in the future on the *Withdrawal Survey*. Of the 246 *Withdrawal Survey* respondents, 85 percent (consistent with previous year) initially enrolled with the intent to graduate from OSUIT.

The *Withdrawal Survey* provides respondents with a checklist of potential student issues that, in whole or in part, help to identify the factors that led to their withdrawal from school (Appendix A). *Work* (21.8%) was the most-cited reason for leaving school; combined with *Conflict between job and school, Accepted full-time job,* and *My job does not require more college,* work-related issues

accounted for 41.8 percent of the reasons given (see "Why are you leaving?" in Appendix A for breakdown of checklist responses).

For *Withdrawal Survey* respondents, 30 (12.2%) reported receiving tutoring services through the LASSO Center; 18 (7.3%) accessed campus counseling services; 86 (35.0%) discussed withdrawal with their academic advisors; 72 (29.3%) spoke with a financial aid counselor before withdrawal. Reasons given for not accessing services are included with the results tables in Appendix A.

When asked "How could we have helped you stay in school?" 33 (13.4%) reported that *more flexible schedules* would have helped; 23 (9.4%) reported *more scholarships* would have helped. The largest category, the open-ended "other" responses (35.8%) included financial support, scheduling issues, specific course offerings, more flexibility dealing with specific student needs, and a wide variety of other responses. However, several mentioned that OSUIT was not at fault and that the problems experienced were unknown or unavoidable.

When asked to make comments about OSUIT's services to students, 32 of 46 comments made indicated positive feelings about OSUIT overall. Eight of the withdrawing students expressed their intentions to return to OSUIT once they had cleared up whatever issues they faced. Negative comments included difficulties with seeking services over the phone or through email or attempting to communicate with instructors. Several comments dealt with expansion of online course offerings and flexible schedules for those who work during the day; see the comments in their entirety in Appendix A.

Finally, a four-year data comparison (academic years 2014-2015 through 2017-2018) is located in Appendix C; this comparison includes tables and trend lines only. For open-ended comments and "other" responses, please refer to the specific *Withdrawing Students* report in osuit.edu/research/ under Reports & Surveys and the "Withdrawing Student Survey" tab.




