



2018 OrangeFest Chalk Walk

Official Rules

Entry is free!

Entry/Registration:

Registration will begin Friday, April 13 at 1:00 pm at the OSUIT OrangeFest Registration table located on the corner of 7th and Morton. Artists must register at this table before drawing is begun. Squares around the Council House will be taped off and offered on a first come, first served basis. Artwork must be suitable for public viewing and will be at the discretion of OSUIT and Main Street event officials. Entry forms may be picked up at the Okmulgee Main Street Office or on-site at the event.

The artist (including minors) must agree to the re-use, publish and re-published photography of the artist or artwork in any media. The artist (including minors) further grants Okmulgee Main Street the use of the artists' name and likeness in any media.

Teams:

Teams may include up to four people.

Theme:

OrangeFest!

Times:

May begin artwork at 1:00 p.m. Judging will begin at 6:00 p.m., and winners will be announced at 7 p.m.

Categories:

Ribbons & prizes will be awarded to winners in each category. Artwork will be judged separately in the following categories: Adult (18 yrs +), Youth (12 – 17 yrs), and Kids (6 – 11 yrs)

Best of Show

All artists are automatically entered in this category. The judges will be looking for the best of all the artwork in the competition.

Kid's Gallery (1yrs-5yrs)

There will be a designated area on the north side of the Council House Square for young children (1-5) to chalk. These drawings will NOT be judged.

Children and Adults Working Together:

Yes, this is allowed! Please Note: If an adult does ANY chalking, the team MUST be registered in the ADULT category. Adults may watch their children or students, but they may not help them "fill in" or create any of the artwork.

Judges:

Judges will be determined prior to the festival. They will be unbiased local people consisting of festival sponsors, featured artists, and/or members of the "Chalk Walk" committee. Judging will begin at 6:00 p.m. and winners will be announced at approximately 7:00 p.m. on the main stage. A group photo of the winners will follow.

Chalk:

Chalk will be provided to all artists at registration (limited supplies). The artwork must be completed using water-based, temporary chalk. If you would like to bring your own chalk, please do! It MUST be water based,

dry pastel chalk or temporary chalk and approved at registration. Oil-based media, fixatives and all other permanent media are not allowed. After the festival ends, the drawings will soon wash away by the rain or with traffic. Make sure you take plenty of photos, as these drawings will not stay forever outdoors.
